COPYRIGHT DISPUTE POLICY

JamTheWire.com (the "Site") has adopted the following general policy toward copyright infringement in accordance with the <u>Digital Millennium Copyright</u> Act (DMCA). The contact information to receive a Notification of Claimed Infringement ("Designated Agent") is listed at the end of this document. It is our policy to (1) block access to or remove material that we believe in good faith to be copyrighted material that has been illegally copied and distributed by any of our website's content providers; and (2) remove content that we have been notified to be so.

Procedure for Reporting Copyright Infringements:

If you believe that material or content residing on or accessible through the Site infringes a copyright, please send a notice of copyright infringement containing the following information to the address below:

- A physical or electronic signature of a person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the copyright that has been allegedly infringed;
- Identification of works or materials being infringed or that is claimed to be infringing including information regarding the location on the Site of the materials that the copyright owner seeks to have removed, with sufficient detail so that we are capable of finding and verifying its existence;
- Contact information about the notifier including email address, street address and telephone number:
- A statement that the notifier has a good faith belief that the material identified is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law; and
- A statement made under penalty of perjury that the information provided is accurate and the notifying party is authorized to make the complaint on behalf of the copyright owner.

Once we receive a complete notice of copyright infringement we will:

- Remove or disable access to the infringing material within 10 business days of notification
- Notify the content provider that it has been removed or disabled access to the material on the Site:

Procedure to Supply a Counter-Notice to us:

If the content provider believes that the material that was removed (or to which access was disabled) is not infringing, or the content provider, member or user believes that it has the right to post and use such material from the copyright owner, the copyright owner's agent, or, pursuant to the law, the content provider, member, or user, must send a counter-notice containing the following information to the address below:

- A physical or electronic signature of the content provider, member or user;
- Identification of the material that has been removed or to which access has been disabled and the location at which the material appeared before it was removed or disabled;
- A statement that the content provider, member or user has a good faith belief that the material was removed or disabled as a result of mistake or misidentification of the material; and
- Content provider's, member's, or user's name, address, telephone number, and, if available, email address.



COPYRIGHT DISPUTE POLICY

If we receive a counter-notice, we may send a copy of the counter-notice to the original complaining party informing that person that we may replace the removed material or cease disabling it in 10 business days unless we hear by electronic notification from them. If the complaining party persists, then any further action will require the content provider and the complaining party to resolve the issue and submit a jointly signed statement to us before we replace the removed material and allow access on the Site. Once we receive such notification, we will restore the content in 10 to 14 business days or more after receipt of the jointly-signed statement, at our discretion.
